Dear 4-Star Trailer Owner;

This **Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

#### REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Dexter Axle Company has decided that a potential defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain trailers equipped with covered electric/hydraulic brake actuators manufactured from September, 2011 through December 19, 2011. Specifically, that a quantity of these pumps had not been properly heat treated. This condition can cause premature wear of some critical components in these pumps which can render the unit inoperable. The electric/hydraulic brake actuator provides braking power to the trailer brakes. Failure of this actuator can result in the loss of braking effort by the trailer.

Your trailer, identified with this Owner Notification Letter is affected. For this reason we ask that you arrange for service to correct the condition without delay. The service and required parts as described in this letter, will be provided free of charge.

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Contact Dexter Axles Warranty Department at (574) 295-7888 and they will direct you to the nearest service center to have the unit replaced at no charge.
