Dear Blattner Energy:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Midsota Manufacturing has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in Dexter Electric/Hydraulic actuators.

! I M P O R T A N T !

- Your Midsota trailer serial #1M9AS2227CA633180
With the UNIT# 610472 is being recalled
- You should contact Midsota with the location of the trailer and verify the serial number on the Dexter brake actuator serial number falls into the recall period of 10/2011-12/2011. Midsota will then send out a replacement actuator.

Why is a recall being conducted?	In December of 2011 Dexter notified the NHTSA that a defect exists in certain E/H brake actuator pumps sold for use in trailers. This condition can cause premature wear of some critical components in these pumps which could render them inoperable.
What are we doing about the problem?	Dexter will replace the brake actuator at no cost within two weeks.
What should you do?	Obtain the serial number of the Dexter brake actuator on the above referenced trailer that Midsota Manufacturing has manufactured for your company. Call Midsota with that serial number so it can be verified you have a defective pump and Midsota will send you a new actuator for your trailer.
What if you no longer own this item?	If you no longer own the above referenced trailer with vin numer1M9AS2227CA633180. Please forward this letter onto the current owner.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days. If you have already paid to have your Dexter Electric/Hydraulic brake actuator repaired for this condition, you may be eligible for reimbursement of the charges you paid for the replacement.
