

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL
NHTSA RECALL #12V-158

Dear Toyota Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Gulf States Toyota, Inc. (GST) has decided that certain model year 2012 Tacoma vehicles fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110, "Tire and Loading Information Placard."

The Tire and Loading Information Placard is a silver label (see diagram below) located on the driver's side center pillar. The Placard provides the recommended cold tire inflation pressure for the front, back and spare tires as well as tire size designation for front, rear and spare tires.

The affected vehicles contain an incorrect Tire and Loading Information Placard regarding the factory spare tire. An incorrect placard could lead to improper spare tire use or replacement which could result in a tire failure, increasing the risk of crash.

Our records indicate that you are the owner of a 2012 Toyota Tacoma that is equipped with an incorrect Tire and Loading Information Placard. GST is initiating a safety recall to install a corrected Tire and Loading Information Placard.

What should you do?

Enclosed you will find a new Tire and Loading Information Placard for your specific vehicle. Please affix the enclosed Placard to your vehicle. Installation instructions are located on the following page.

- If you no longer own the vehicle, please call Gulf States Toyota, Inc. at 1-800-444-1074.
- If you are a vehicle Lessor, Federal law requires you to forward a copy of this notice to the Lessee within ten days.

What should you do if you have further questions or any problems?

If you have any further questions, or if you have a problem installing the corrected Placard, please contact your local Toyota Dealer to schedule an appointment if you are in Texas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, Arkansas, or Mississippi. They will install it free of charge. Tire and Loading Information Placard Installation Instructions

APPLY the NEW TIRE LABEL

- 1, Clean the existing Tire and Loading Information Label and the surrounding areas using a clean, dry cloth to remove any dust or dirt.
2. Affix the new Tire Label over the current label. Be sure to cover the existing label.
