



## *Safety Recall Notice*

Dear Customer:

This **Safety Recall Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

### **Reason for This Recall**

Airstream has decided that certain 2012 model year International trailers fail to comply with the requirements of 49CFR part 567, "Certification" in the United States.

On the vehicles subject to this recall, the Federal Identification Label and Tire and Loading Information label does not contain the correct tire information. The labels list the wrong tire and rim size. The size should be ST225/75R16E tires with 80 psi/552 Kpa tire pressure and 16 X 6 J rims and was listed as ST225/75R15D tires with 65 psi/448 Kpa tire pressure and 15 X 6JJ rims. During replacement of the tires, a consumer could install the incorrect tire potentially leading to property damage.

### **What We Will Do**

Airstream has enclosed the corrected labels to remedy the situation.

### **What You Should Do**

At your earliest convenience, apply the new Compliance Label over top of the existing label. If you require assistance installing the labels, please make an appointment with your dealer and bring the unit to the dealership and they will install the labels at no cost to you.
