NOTICE OF POSSIBLE DEFECT Trailer serial # 541604 NHTSA # 12V-206

Dear Sir:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Wilson Trailer has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists on certain (vehicles) equipped with Dexter Axle.

Dexter Axle electric/hydraulic brake actuator pumps. Dexter Axle was notified by the supplier of the hydraulic pump used in electric/hydraulic brake actuator that a quantity of these pumps had not been properly heat treated. This condition can cause premature wear of some critical components in those pumps which can render the unit inoperable. The electric/hydraulic brake actuator provides braking power to the trailer brakes. Failure of this actuator can result in the loss of braking effort by the trailer, increasing the risk of a vehicle crash.

Each of these electric/hydraulic actuators carries a unique serial number. We have identified a range of serial numbers which may contain the defective pumps. Our records show your trailer has been produced in this time frame and could be involved. More information from Dexter Axle regarding the electric/hydraulic actuator recall is included with this letter... The serial numbers involved are listed as well as a picture of the actuator label. Any actuators within this serial number range should be sent back to Dexter Axle

The remedy will consist of the replacement of potentially defective units and will be done at no charge to you... Please contact Denise Schrock at Dexter Customer Service at 1-800-400-2164. Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of the notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you have had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. We regret any inconvenience that this action may cause you. However, we are concerned about your safety.
