Dear Kenworth Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that certain Kenworth T680 vehicles manufactured with 76" sleepers between February 2, 2012 and April 30, 2012, fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard, Standard 302 "Flammability of Interior Materials". Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain a defect.

Grey or tan colored bunk restraint harnesses used in the affected T680 vehicles with 76" sleepers do not meet the requirements of FMVSS 302 for flammability of interior materials.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Grey or tan bunk restraint harnesses do not meet FMVSS 302 for flammability of interior materials
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Replace grey or tan bunk restraint harnesses with black harnesses
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Kenworth has initiated a recall to replace the grey or tan color-matched bunk restraint harnesses with black harnesses. Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. To find your nearest Kenworth dealer, please visit Dealer Locator at www.Kenworth.com. This repair should take less than 1 hour, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

If you require further information about this recall, reimbursement of a pre-notification remedy associated with this recall or experience any difficulty in making arrangements for this repair, please contact: Kenworth Truck Company, P.O. Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you no longer own this vehicle, we would appreciate your advising us of the new owner if you know their name. The enclosed card may be used for this purpose.
