SAFETY RECALL NOTICE
2012 Karma Low Temperature Cooling Fan Voluntary Safety Recall 520120016

Fisker Karma Vehicle «VIN»

Dear Fisker Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Fisker Automotive has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2012 model year Fisker Karma vehicles.

What is the condition?

A manufacturing defect in the low temperature cooling fan may result in a direct short which may ignite the fan housing, shroud, and surrounding components, potentially causing a vehicle fire.

What will Fisker Automotive do?

To remedy the defect, your Fisker retailer will remove two potentially affected low temperature cooling fans and replace them with one improved low temperature cooling fan. A resistive cap will also be installed. In addition, a 20-amp fuse will be added in line for improved circuit protection. There will be absolutely no charge to you for this service. Labor, the replacement cooling fan, and other parts will be provided free of charge.

What should you do?

We urge you to contact your Fisker retailer as promptly as possible to arrange for your vehicle to be serviced.

The low temperature cooling fan motor replacement will take approximately 2 hours to complete. However, additional time may be required depending on how retailer appointments are scheduled and processed.

Your Fisker retailer will be able to answer most questions you might have about this recall. However, if you require further assistance, please contact Fisker Consumer Affairs at 1-855-575-7577, Option 2 [6am – 7pm (PST), Monday through Friday].

If you have sold your vehicle or have taken it out of service, please contact Fisker Consumer Affairs and provide contact information of your purchaser so that we may notify him/her of this important information.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.



If you believe that the retailer or Fisker Automotive has failed, or, is unable to remedy the defect within a reasonable time, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue S.E., Washington, DC 20590 or call the toll free Vehicle Safety Hot Line at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153), or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
