SAFETY RECALL INTERIM NOTICE G-12525

NOVEMBER 2012

Dear INTERNATIONAL® Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Navistar Bus has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 3300, 3000 RE, 3200IM, CE C, FBC, FC C, FE C, RC C and RE C commercial bus models built 16 March, 2005 thru 24 February, 2009 with certain I-6 engines.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The engine high pressure oil line may develop a leak or possibly rupture. A leak or rupture of the high pressure oil line could possibly result in an unexpected engine stall or in rare cases may result in an engine compartment fire.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Engine shut down without warning, or the possibility of fire in the engine compartment of a bus could have evacuation concerns, which could result in property damage or personal injury.

DEFECT REMEDY

A Remedy has been developed. However, repair parts will not be available until late December 2012. When parts become available, you will be notified again of additional actions you should take.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.
