2003-2012 KME AerialCat Vehicles Equipped with Electronic Controls
Manufactured between July 2003 and March 2012

- (1) The notification campaign identification number assigned to this matter by NHTSA is 12V027000.
- (2) The date notification began is April 9, 2012. A second notification was forwarded to non-responsive customers on July 9, 2012. The first and second notifications to customers have been completed. If necessary, it is KME's intention to follow-up with non-responsive customers.
- (3) The number of vehicles or items of equipment involved in the subject notification campaign is 122.
- (4) The total number of vehicles and equipment items which have been inspected and repaired to date is 105. No determination has been made regarding any of the subject vehicles that may not need the repair. All of the subject vehicles are being repaired regardless of whether they have manifested the defect.
- (5) No vehicles or items of equipment have been determined to be unreachable for inspection due to export, theft, scrapping, failure to receive notification or any other reasons.
- (6) There are no vehicles or items of equipment repaired and/or returned by dealers, other retailers, and/or distributors to the manufacturer prior to their first sale to the public.
- (7) The subject recall does not involve replacement of tires.
