The recall involves certain 2012 Dodge and Chrysler Entervan ADA mobility conversion vans. There is a possibility that aftermarket seat covers were installed incorrectly with the airbag tag toward the inboard side of the seat rather than correctly toward the outboard side of the seat where the OEM side seat airbag is positioned. If the seat covers are installed on the incorrect seats, the seat cover will not allow side airbag deployment during a vehicle crash, increasing the risk of injury to the vehicle occupants.
