Dear Peterbilt Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain vehicles built between January 31, 2011 and January 20, 2012, and equipped with Bendix ATR-6 brake valves. Our records indicate that your vehicle, identified by the VIN at the top of this letter, was manufactured within this time period and may contain the defect described herein.

In extremely cold conditions (at or below 0 degrees Fahrenheit / -18 degrees Celsius), Bendix ATR-6 valves may develop an internal leak, resulting in pressure being delivered to the affected service brakes. Pressure delivered to the affected service brake circuit may cause intermittent foundation brake application. The pressure being delivered may even cause a continuous brake application. Continuous brake application may result in a fire at the affected wheel end. In certain low traction operating conditions, an unexpected brake application may affect vehicle handling, possibly causing a crash.

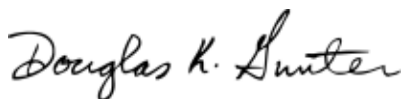
