Dear Peterbilt Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt has decided that Peterbilt Model 210 and 220 vehicles built between November 23, 2011 and September 27, 2012 fail to comply with certain state and federal requirements related to exterior lighting. Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain a defect.

Exterior lighting conditions that are not in compliance include: 1) fog lamps can be activated with high beam headlights turned on, 2) with the key on, the Daytime Running Lights (DRL) are activated and cannot be switched off, and 3) when the DRL's are activated the high beam headlamps can be activated. These conditions are out of compliance with certain federal regulations.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Exterior lighting does not comply with state and federal regulations
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Install a wiring harness jumper to correct the lighting issues.
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Peterbilt Motors Company has initiated a recall to install a wiring harness to correct the exterior lighting compliance issues. Please contact your Peterbilt dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair. This repair should take less than one half hour, and will be performed at no charge to you. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

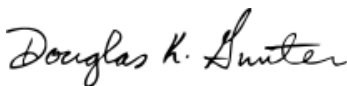
