This letter serves to acknowledge Logan Coach's notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) of a safety recall which will be conducted pursuant to Federal law for the product(s) listed below. Problem Description:

Logan Coach is recalling certain model year 2013 Razor 3-Horse Gooseneck trailers. Due to a design change in the power awning motor assembly, the motor assembly screws may unknowingly shear.

Consequence:

If the motor assembly screws shear, it is possible that the awning can unfurl unexpectedly, either while the vehicle is at rest or while in transit, increasing the risk of personal injury or a vehicle crash.

Remedy:

Logan Coach will notify owners and Dometic staff will replace the affected motors with motors of a different design. The recall is expected to begin in July 2013. Owners may contact Logan Coach at 1-800-742-7047 or Dometic at 1-888-447-0003 for more information. Owners are being instructed not to drive their vehicle until repairs can be performed.

We have received Logan Coach's proposed owner notification letter and it is currently under review. You will be notified of any changes or concerns once our review is complete.

Please be reminded of the following requirements:

Logan Coach must submit a sample of the envelope in which you intend to mail the recall notice to owners. The words "SAFETY," "RECALL," and "NOTICE," in any order, must be printed on the envelope in all capital letters, in a type larger than that used in the address section, and in a manner distinguishable from the other type in a manner other than size (for example, in a different font or color).

Copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

We understand that Dometic will be conducting this safety recall. However, since Logan Coach is responsible for the defect in accordance with 49 CFR §573.5, please be advised that if Dometic's safety recall campaign is not successful, the agency may require Logan Coach to conduct a follow-up notification.
