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## DEFECT INFORMATION REPORT

1. **Manufacturer's name/address:** Terex South Dakota, Inc., 500 Oakwood Road, Watertown, SD 57201 is the equipment manufacturer.
2. **Equipment involved in this defect notification:** OM Aerial Devices manufactured from 1998 to 2005 by Terex South Dakota, Inc. The aerial device is installed on trucks used to elevate personnel for utility work while parked and stationary.
3. **Total number of vehicles or items of equipment:** 500 units may be affected.
4. **Approximate percentage of vehicles or equipment estimated to actually contain the defect:** Approximately 20% of the potentially affected aerials may experience the defect.
5. **Description of the defect:** The leveling arm at the elbow can develop fatigue cracks.
6. **Chronological summary of events leading to this determination:** A failure of the leveling arm was reported in March. Since then other units have been inspected and additional unit discovered with fatigue cracks.
7. **The determination of existence of problem:** The report of a failed arm
8. **Description of proposed remedy:** The leveling arm will be repaired.
9. **Program for remedy campaign (including program for reimbursing any consumer who obtained the remedy at his/her own expense within one year of the opening of the EA, or within one year of this 573 report, whichever is earlier):** Repairs will be covered under warranty.
