Dear Ms. Lewis:

Winnebago Industries, Inc. submits the following addendum to our April 22, 2013 letter regarding Winnebago Industries® Recall 128. The "Chalet"® model originally listed in our April 22, 2013 letter has been removed from the recall as this model was found to have the stove enclosure installed. Removing this model reduces the number of vehicles containing the defect by 152 vehicles.

Lines 2 and 3 should now read as follows and numbered paragraphs below correspond to those found at Part 573.6(c).

2. The motor vehicles potentially containing the defect are on certain 2012, 2013, and 2014 Model Year Winnebago® (Models: Minnie Winnie®, Aspect®, Sightseer®, Adventurer®, and Journey®); certain 2012, 2013, and 2014 Model Year Itasca® (Models: Spirit®, Cambria®, Sunova®, Suncruiser®, and Meridian®).

These motorhomes were manufactured January 10, 2012 through April 5, 2013. The vehicles were identified using production records showing models and VINs.

3. The total number of vehicles potentially containing the defect is 1,918 (1,775 in field / 143 corrected prior to shipment).
