Re: Recall 13V-405 –Part 573 Report Update

On September 5, 2013, Suzuki Motor of America, Inc. ("SMAI") submitted a Part 573 report concerning a defect in certain 2006-2011 model year Suzuki Grand Vitara and 2007-2011 model year Suzuki SX4 vehicles. In this report, SMAI identified the number of affected vehicles as 193,936 and indicated that this number excluded vehicles that had a countermeasure part installed under a special coverage campaign that Suzuki had been conducting.

In November 2013, because a sufficient supply of recall parts was not yet available to start the recall, owners were sent an interim notification letter. The interim letter explained that a second notification letter would be sent when sufficient parts were available to start the recall and informed owners that the special coverage campaign that Suzuki had been conducting would continue until the recall begins. Suzuki is now ready to start the recall and begin sending second recall notification letters. We would now like to update the number of affected vehicles to exclude all vehicles that had a countermeasure part installed under the special coverage campaign, as of the date that the vehicle list for the second recall notification was finalized. The new number of affected vehicles for Recall No. 13V-405 is 189,793.
