Identification of Vehicles

The vehicle models involved in this recall are:
2012 model year Essex Class A motor home
2012 model year King Aire Class A motor home

These vehicles were manufactured by Newmar Corporation between 12/15/2010 and 8/15/2011.

Comprehensive Vehicle Population

The total number of vehicles included in this campaign is 31.

Effected Population Assessment

100% of the vehicles identified above may contain defective equipment.

Defect Description

According to the defect notification from Spartan Motor Chassis Corporation, Spartan has become aware of an issue on the Ametek 4-in1 Gauge. A gauge calculation error that provides for a gauge accuracy reading of greater than 7% of the compressor cut out pressure.

Certain recreational vehicles manufactured by Newmar Corporation, as Identified above, were built on chassis manufactured by Spartan Motor Chassis Corporation which were equipped by Spartan Motor Chassis Corporation with Ametek 4-in1 Gauge that have been identified by Spartan Motor Chassis Corporation as potentially hazardous. Spartan Motor Chassis Corporation has filed recall with NHTSA serving notice of their intent to recall these Ametek 4-in1 Gages.
