Description of the Defect : Updated on Dec.22, 2015; The subject 149 vehicles under 13V130, 2003-2004MY Mazda6, 147units, and 2004 MY RX-8, 2units ,are moved into new Part573 submitted on 12/22/2015 involved with 2003-2008MY Mazda6, 2005-2007MY Mazdaspeed6 and 2004MY RX-8. Therefore, Mazda is closing this 13V130. Mazda is recalling certain model year 2003-2004 Mazda6 vehicles manufactured January 14, 2003, through May 29, 2003; and 2004 RX-8 vehicles manufactured June 25, 2003, through June 30, 2003, to address a safety defect in the passenger side air bag which may produce excessive internal pressure causing the inflator to rupture upon deployment of the air bag.

Description of the Safety Risk : In the event of a crash necessitating deployment of the passenger's air bag, the inflator could rupture with metal fragments striking and potentially seriously injuring the passenger seat occupant or other occupants.
