Description of Remedy Program : FCA US will conduct a voluntary safety recall to replace the left outer tie rod on all affected Dodge Ram Vehicles. Alternatively, for vehicles that have not already been remedied pursuant to this safety recall, FCA US will offer to eligible owners of affected Dodge Ram vehicles to refund the purchase price paid by the first purchaser of the vehicle for purposes other than resale, less a reasonable allowance for depreciation, and not including the cost of modifications made to the vehicle after first retail sale ("Purchase Price"). FCA US will additionally offer a premium of 10% above the Purchase Price to any eligible owner of an unremedied vehicle electing this alternative remedy.

FCA US has a longstanding policy and practice of reimbursing owners who have incurred the cost of repairing a problem that subsequently becomes the subject of a field action. To ensure consistency, FCA US, as part of the owner letter, will request that customers send the original receipt and/or other adequate proof of payment to the company for confirmation of the expense.
