Dear Valued Starcraft Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Starcraft has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Model Year 2014 16BH AR-ONE travel trailers manufactured between June 3, 2013 and September 30, 2013. These units were built with tires of a lower load range than the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating requires which could result in the tires being overloaded, and lead to tire failure increasing the risk of a crash.

The remedy is replacement of the current tires/rims and spare with new ST175/80R13D tires/rims, as well as replacement of labels that do not call out the correct tire size as ST175/80R13D.

According to our records, the following unit/s are in your possession and must have this recall performed prior to being retail sold: (Vin #)

All unsold vehicles in your possession that are subject to this campaign must be held and repaired per the service procedure of this recall campaign bulletin **before** owners take possession of these vehicles. **Federal law requires that all units in your inventory be repaired prior to delivery to a customer. If you have sold a unit recently that you have received a stock recall notice on, please contact the owner immediately to advise of the recall.**
