Dear Mr. Lafon:

During a recent audit of our recall files we identified a considerable discrepancy in safety recall 13V-039 between the numbers of products Prevost reported it would be recalling, and the number it reported in its quarterly completion as campaigned. Specifically, Prevost notified us that 1,033 of products were being recalled, but the 3rd quarter report indicates 1,493 of products were campaigned.

Please explain this discrepancy and confirm the correct number of products being recalled so that we may adjust our recalls as necessary. A copy of the information you provide will be posted in the public file for this recall. If Prevost did notify us of an adjustment to the population but our files were not updated, we sincerely apologize, and request a copy of your notification.

We respectfully request that Prevost review its population totals and other information it has reported on its recall on a periodic basis so as to avoid future discrepancies, and so we can continue to work as productively as possible in ensuring safety critical campaigns are as successful as possible. Prevost is reminded that it is obligated to notify our office within five business days of when it has new information that update or corrects the products it told us it intends to recall, the number of those products, the planned remedy, or the estimated date(s) for notifying owners and purchasers.
