Recall Campaign No. 13V-017: Drivetrain

Dear Electronaut:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

BMW AG has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2011 ActiveE vehicles. Our records indicate that you are the driver of a potentially affected vehicle.

We sincerely apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you.

## IMPORTANT

We contacted you by telephone and by email to let you know that your vehicle is affected by this Recall, but were unable to reach you. Therefore, we are sending you this letter, and request that you contact your authorized BMW ActiveE center to schedule an appointment as soon as possible.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROBLEM

This Recall involves the drivetrain. On affected vehicles, the sealing of the electric motor housing may be inadequate. This can allow a lack of grease to occur on the transmission gear shaft, causing a possible loss of lubrication. Over time, this could lead to excessive wear of the gearing and, ultimately, to a loss of vehicle propulsion, increasing the risk of a crash.

## DESCRIPTION OF REPAIR

The drivetrain connection will be inspected, and the sealing system will be updated. If the electric motor gearing is significantly worn, it will be replaced.

The sealing system update may take up to 2 days. If the electric motor gearing needs to be replaced, it may take more than 2 days, depending upon parts availability. Additional time may be required, depending upon the center's schedule. The repair will be performed *free of charge* by your authorized BMW ActiveE center.
