This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Kenworth Truck Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Kenworth model T680 and T880 vehicles manufactured between January 18, 2012 and February 25, 2013. Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain a defect.

The seat belt buckle anchoring cables may fray after being repeatedly bent during use. A frayed seatbelt cable could cause the belt system to fail in its function of restraining an occupant during a rapid deceleration or crash, resulting in possible injury or death.

The problem is...	Seat belt anchoring cables can fray and fail
What your dealer will do...	Replace the seat belt anchor cables
What you must do ...	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment

Kenworth has initiated a recall to replace the seat belt anchor cables in your truck. Please contact your Kenworth dealer immediately to schedule an appointment for this repair.
