This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act

Triumph Motorcycles has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Triumph Tiger, Speed Triple, Street Triple and Daytona motorcycles requiring the turn signal stems to be replaced. Failure to undertake this work could lead to the stems fracturing. Our records show that you are the owner of an affected motorcycle.

To correct this condition, your dealer will replace turn signal stems. The service and parts will be provided free of charge. This work will take about ½ hour to complete however, additional time may be required depending on how dealer appointments are scheduled and processed. We urge you to contact your local Triumph dealer immediately to arrange an early appointment with the service department.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
