



NHTSA Recall (13V-145)

Dear E-One Chassis Owner:

May 3, 2013

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

E-One has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain E-One 2011-2013 Cyclone II model Chassis manufactured between April 22, 2011 and February 08, 2013, equipped with certain Meritor axles, equipped with MGM Brand Type 24 J-Series Piston Parking Brake Actuators. Meritor is recalling their axles that are equipped with this actuator. (Recall 13E-012) The actuator seal may have intermittent air leakage that may cause low air pressure in the actuator and allow the parking brake spring to apply force to the brake. Depending on the leakage, the brake can drag while the vehicle is in service or prevent the wheel from rotating. This could result in elevated brake operating temperatures and possibly a wheel end / brake fire. These conditions could increase the risk of a crash.

WHAT WE WILL DO

E-One will be contacting owners of the affected E-One Chassis and inspect the Brake Actuator date code, and replace, if needed, free of charge.

The Safety Recall is expected to start on or before May 3, 2013

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

If you receive this notification, please contact your authorized E-One Service Center to schedule an appointment, or call E-One at 1-800-627-5050 to schedule an inspection of the Actuator Date Code and replacement of the actuator if needed.

If the repairs are not completed within three (3) days of the agreed on service date, and they do not remedy this condition on that date or within three (3) days, we recommend you contact E-One customer service by calling 1-800-627-5050. If you have incurred any out of pocket expenses associated with the recall, you may be eligible for reimbursement. For more information, please contact our customer service at 1-800-627-5050.
