FITMENT OF A THROTTLE CABLE GUIDE

MAY 2013

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act

Triumph has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year Triumph Street Triple, Street Triple R, Street Triple ABS, Street Triple R ABS, Daytona 675, Daytona 675 ABS, Daytona 675 R, Daytona 675 R ABS motorcycles require the fitment of a throttle cable guide and for the throttle cables to be visual checked and replaced if necessary. Failure to undertake this work could lead a loss of control of the motorcycle, increasing the risk of a crash.

To correct this condition, your dealer will perform a visual check of the throttle cables and replacement where required along with the fitment of a throttle wire guide. This work will take approximately ½ hour to complete. We urge you to contact your local Triumph dealer immediately to arrange an early appointment with the service department. The service and parts will be provided free of charge.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
