REPLACE FUEL TANK-NHTSA Recall Campaign No:13V-223

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act

VIN:

Triumph has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year Triumph Trophy SE motorcycles requiring the fuel to be replaced. Failure to undertake this work could lead to an unexpected loss of fuel which could increase the risk of a crash resulting property damage and/or personal injury. A fuel leak in the presence of an ignition source may also result in a fire.

To correct this condition, your dealer will replace the fuel tank. The service and parts will be provided free of charge. This work will take about 1.5 hours to complete however, additional time may be required depending on how dealer appointments are scheduled and processed. We urge you to contact your local Triumph dealer immediately to arrange an early appointment with the service department.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
