**IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE
NHTSA RECALL NO. 13V-480**

December 17, 2013

Dear Blue Bird Owner:

This important safety recall notice applies to your buses identified by both Blue Bird Body Number and Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) on the attached yellow cover sheet.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Blue Bird Body Company has decided in conjunction with Sure Power Inc. a division of Eaton's Controls and Power Conversion that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Blue Bird commercial series non-school buses built with split 12/24 volt electrical systems and equipped with Sure Power battery equalizers. The subject buses were manufactured as indicated below by model year and commercial bus model.

Blue Bird 2004 model year Ultra LMB model commercial buses delivered from June 19, 2003 through March 28, 2006.

Blue Bird 2003 through 2006 model year Ultra LF model commercial buses delivered from March 14, 2003 through April 01, 2008.

Blue Bird 2004 through 2007 model year Express 4000 model commercial buses delivered from September 27, 2003 through April 03, 2007.

Blue Bird 2004 through 2007 model year Express 4500 model commercial buses delivered from March 15, 2004 through May 19, 2007.

Certain Sure Power, Inc. battery equalizers sold through Blue Bird Aftermarket Parts Sales from July 15, 2005 through February 08, 2011.

Sure Power has advised Blue Bird that the subject buses have an electrical component in the battery equalizer which may experience a failure mode potentially resulting in smoke being emitted or excessive heat being produced which could possibly result in melting and burning increasing the risk of a fire. Blue Bird is conducting a recall to correct this defect.

To correct this condition the battery equalizer part number must be determined. If the battery equalizer part number is found to be one of the defective battery equalizer part numbers, it must be replaced. The part number, serial number, date inspected and body number must be recorded on the attached ***Recall R13WN Inspection Reply Sheet*** and returned to Blue Bird Body Company in one of the pink postage prepaid envelopes.

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Replacement battery equalizers will be shipped to you from Sure Power Inc. or its designee at no charge to you. Replacement battery equalizers are anticipated to be available from Sure Power Inc. in the first quarter of 2014. You must provide the correct shipping address, contact name and telephone number on the enclosed *Recall R13WN Inspection Reply Sheet* in order to receive replacement battery equalizers. A qualified technician should perform both the inspection and, if needed, removal and replacement of the battery equalizer.

Time allowed for inspecting and recording the battery equalizer part number and serial number is 0.1 hour per bus.

If required, time allowed to remove and replace the battery equalizer is 2.0 hours per bus. This includes time for inspecting and recording the battery equalizer serial number. Defective battery equalizers removed must be disposed of according to Federal, State and local government requirements.

To receive reimbursement for labor you must complete the attached pink *R13WN Recall Reimbursement Sheet* and return to Blue Bird Recall Administration in the pink self-addressed postage paid reply envelope so our records may be updated. This will prevent you from receiving further follow up notices. The completed pink *R13WN Recall Reimbursement Sheet* may also be faxed to 478-822-2467.

Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If the modifications directed by this notification were performed on your bus prior to the receipt of this recall notification, complete and sign the recall reply sheet and attached a copy of the work order/invoice. Mail the documents in the **pink** self-addressed postage paid envelope included with the recall notification to Blue Bird for warranty consideration. Reimbursements will be made in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Transportation Safety Act, Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Parts 573 and 577.
