Dear Kaiying Wang:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Porsche has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2013 and 2014 Cayenne, Cayenne Diesel, Cayenne S Hybrid, Cayenne S, Cayenne GTS, Cayenne Turbo, and Cayenne Turbo S vehicles. Our records indicate that you are the owner or lessee of one of these vehicles.

During new vehicle evaluation testing, it was discovered that the fuel level senders on the affected vehicles may not have been calibrated correctly during the production process. As a result, the fuel gauge may read high, and the range on remaining fuel displayed in the instrument cluster may be higher than the actual range. If the driver relies on the fuel gauge or the displayed (incorrect) driving range before refueling, the vehicle will come to a standstill due to lack of fuel even though the instrument cluster displays a remaining possible driving distance. As a result, occupants of the vehicle may become stranded and require roadside assistance. Also, if the driver is unable to maneuver to vehicle off the road, a vehicle crash could occur.

Porsche has decided to conduct a safety recall to correct this situation. Until the recall is performed, the vehicle is still safe to drive. However, in order to avoid running out of fuel, the fuel gauge should not be allowed to go lower than the $\frac{1}{2}$ point; i.e., you should always refill while at least one-half tank of gas remains showing on the fuel gauge.

There are no replacement parts required for this repair. It is merely an update to the vehicle's computer software that will recalibrate the fuel level sender, so the repair period is less than one hour. Nevertheless, we request you contact your authorized Porsche dealership to schedule a repair appointment and to arrange in advance for a Porsche loaner vehicle should you require alternate transportation during the repair period. And, of course, our authorized Porsche dealer will complete the software update at no cost to you.

Please note that Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
