NHTSA RECALL 13V-521

Dear Nissan NV200 Compact Cargo vehicles Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some 2013 Model Year NV200 Compact Cargo vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the Nissan vehicle identified by the VIN on the inside of this notice.

Reason for Recall

On certain Model Year 2013 Nissan NV200 Compact Cargo vehicles, the wiring harness may become damaged over time due to possible friction contact with a metal bracket. This could create a short circuit and cause the engine to stop running which can increase the risk of a crash.

What Nissan Will Do

Your Nissan dealer will inspect the wiring harness and apply a harness kit (corrugated tubing) and remove a clamp next to the harness to help prevent the harness from contacting the bracket. This repair will take around 1 hour to perform. This repair is free of charge to you for parts and labor. If the harness inspection shows damage, an appropriate remedy will be provided. Please note that your Nissan dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule and parts availability.

What You Should Do

Contact your Nissan dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle inspected. Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment.
