Pursuant to Federal Regulation 573.6 – Defect and noncompliance information, Chrysler is providing the following updated information pertaining to Safety Recalls 12V-527 (M35) and 13V-040 (N13).

Chrysler is in the process of mailing the follow-up recall owner notification to complete Safety Recall 12V-527 (M35) on the 2002 – 2004 Jeep Grand Cherokee owners. Chrysler started the follow-up recall owner notification letters on January 22, 2014 and estimates the completion of the follow-up owner notification letters by February 22, 2014 to all US & US Territory owners. Chrysler will provide the updated dealer repair instructions to all Chrysler dealers on January 29, 2014.

Chrysler is in the process of generating the repair procedure to complete Safety Recall 13V-040 (N13) on the 2003-2004 Dodge Viper vehicles. Chrysler estimates the repair procedure will be available to all Chrysler dealers by February 21, 2014. Chrysler estimates the follow-up owner notification letter will be mailed to all US & US Territory owners by February 28, 2014.
