

Honda Recall Voice Alert to Customer

Honda recently mailed you an important safety recall notice regarding your 2005 Pilot. This notice explains that your Vehicle Stability Assist unit may have been damaged during manufacturing. A damaged VSA system may apply a small amount of braking force even if the driver has not pressed the brake pedal. If the driver applies the brakes during a malfunction, the VSA system may cause the vehicle to come to an abrupt stop, increasing the risk of crash. In addition, your vehicle may have a VSA system electrical connector bolt that was not sufficiently tightened which may cause braking force to be applied while driving, without illumination of the brake lights, increasing the risk of a crash. Our records indicate that your vehicle has not yet received the recall repair. Please make an appointment to have your vehicle repaired, free of charge, at any authorized Honda dealer.
