

Subject: Safety (Non-Compliance) Recall D0G – Remedy Notification

Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit Accessory

Designed to fit 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser Vehicles

As previously announced, in April 2013, Toyota filed a Noncompliance Information Report (NCIR) with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) informing the agency that certain 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser vehicles equipped with the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory fail to conform to a provision of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 108. There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter.



Toyota has completed remedy preparation and will begin to notify owners.

Background

The subject Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit is specifically designed for 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser vehicles. The Auxiliary Light Kit consists of two 6-inch 55 Watt lights which are mounted on the front bumper inboard of the headlamp assemblies. The Auxiliary Light Kit can be illuminated when the driver activates the vehicle's high beam lights. The illumination of the Auxiliary Light Kit with the vehicle's high beams causes the vehicle to exceed one of the allowable lighting thresholds specified in FMVSS 108. Light intensities above the maximum allowable limit could cause increased glare for oncoming traffic and increase the risk of a crash.

Remedy

If the vehicle is equipped with a Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit any authorized Toyota dealer will replace the Auxiliary Light Brackets and Bulbs at **NO CHARGE** to the vehicle owner.

The following information is provided to inform you and your dealers of this campaign and your degree of involvement.

1. Owner Notification Mailing Date

The owner notification will commence in late May, 2013.

There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter. In order to identify all the vehicles which may have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit installed Toyota will be mailing owner notices to all owners of 2007 to 2013 model year FJ Cruiser vehicles; this mailing will include approximately 209,000 letters.

If the vehicle does **NOT** have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, it is **NOT** involved in this Safety Recall.

(Owner Notification Mailing Date Continued. . .)

Please note that only owners of the covered vehicles will be notified. If a dealer is contacted by an owner who has not yet received the notification, please *verify coverage by confirming through Dealer Daily/TIS.* Dealers should perform the procedure as outlined in the Technical Instructions located on TIS.

Toyota tries very hard to obtain current customer name and address information when mailing owner letters. In the event your dealership receives a notice for a vehicle that was sold prior to the Safety Recall announcement, it is the dealerships responsibility to forward the owner letter to the customer who purchased the vehicle.

2. New Vehicles in Dealer Stock

As required by Federal law (49 Code of Federal Regulations §577.13), Toyota is advising that dealers are not to deliver any new vehicles in their inventory equipped with the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit Accessory involved in this Safety (Non-Compliance) Recall unless the non-compliance has been remedied. Any Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits currently in dealer inventory must also not be sold. Vehicle Safety Recall completion can be verified through TIS.

3. Pre-Owned Vehicles in Dealer Stock

Toyota requests that dealers verify whether their Pre-Owned vehicles in dealer inventory are covered by this Safety Recall. If a vehicle is covered the dealer should perform the Safety Recall remedy prior to customer delivery.

4. Dealer Summary Reports

Summary Reports, containing the number of covered vehicles in your dealership's primary marketing area, have been enclosed in the dealer package. Please note the numbers of vehicles shown indicates PPO sales as well as over-the-counter sales of the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit. (Please verify eligibility by confirming through Dealer Daily or TIS prior to performing repairs.)

5. Number and Identification of Covered Vehicles

There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter for 2007 to 2013 model year FJ Cruiser vehicles

To ensure over the counter customers are notified approximately 209,000 (2007 to 2013MY) FJ Cruiser owners will receive a notification in the U.S. All 2007 to 2013 MY FJ Cruiser Vehicles will be identified under Safety Recall campaign code D0G.







There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter.

Q1: What is the condition?

A1: The subject Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit is specifically designed for 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser vehicles. The Auxiliary Light Kit consists of two 6-inch 55 Watt lights which are mounted on the front bumper inboard of the headlamp assemblies. The Auxiliary Light Kit can be illuminated when the driver activates the vehicle's high beam lights. The illumination of the Auxiliary Light Kit with the vehicle's high beams causes the vehicle to exceed one of the allowable lighting thresholds specified in FMVSS 108. Light intensities above the maximum allowable limit could cause increased glare for oncoming traffic and increase the risk of a crash.

Q1a: What is the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit?

A1a: The Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit is an optional Toyota accessory which consists of two bumper or brush guard mounted 6-inch round lights and two FJ branded covers to protect the lights when not in use. Please refer to the following images for reference.



<u>Q2: How many Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits are covered by this Safety (Non-Compliance)</u> <u>Recall?</u>

A2: There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter for 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser Vehicles.

Q2a: Are there any other Toyota or Lexus vehicles covered?

A2a: No. The Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit was designed only for use on 2007 to 2013 FJ Cruiser models.

Q2b: Which and how many vehicles are covered by this Safety Recall?

A2b: There are approximately 11,500 vehicles that could have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory installed. To ensure that dealer installations and over-the-counter accessory sales customers are notified, approximately 209,000 letters will be mailed to all 2007 through certain 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser owners.

Q3: What is Toyota going to do?

A3: If the vehicle is equipped with a Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, any authorized Toyota dealer will replace the Auxiliary Light Brackets and Bulbs at **NO CHARGE** to the vehicle owner. Only vehicles equipped with a Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit will require repair.

Q3a: How and when will Toyota notify owner of vehicles covered by this Safety (Non-Compliance) Recall?

A3a: The owner notification is anticipated to start in late May, 2013.

There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter. In order to identify all the vehicles which may have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit installed Toyota will be mailing owner notices to all owners of 2007 to 2013 model year FJ Cruiser vehicles; this mailing will include approximately 209,000 letters.

If the vehicle does **NOT** have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, it is **NOT** involved in this Safety Recall.

Q3b: How does Toyota obtain my mailing information?


A3b: Toyota uses an industry provider who works with each state Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to receive registration or title information. Please make sure your registration or title information is correct.

Q3c: Do I need my owner letter to have the remedy performed?

A3c: You do not need an owner letter to have this recall completed; however, to assist the dealer in confirming vehicle eligibility, we request that you present the owner notification at the time of your service appointment.

Q4: Can I inspect my vehicle to determine if it has the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit?

A4: Yes, you can reference the images shown below to determine if your vehicle is equipped with the optional Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory.



If so equipped, please contact your local authorized Toyota dealer as soon as possible to schedule an appointment to have the remedy performed.

If the vehicle does **NOT** have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, it is **NOT** involved in this Safety Recall and no additional action is necessary.

Q4a: What if I am not comfortable performing the inspection?

A4a: Any authorized Toyota dealer will be more than happy to perform an inspection at **no charge** to you to determine if your vehicle is covered by this safety recall.

Q5: How long will the repair take?

Background


As previously announced, in April 2013, Toyota filed a Non-Compliance Information Report (NCIR) with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) informing the agency that 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser vehicles equipped with the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory kit fail to conform to a provision of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 108. There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter.

Q1: What is the condition?

A1: The subject Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit is specifically designed for 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser vehicles. The Auxiliary Light Kit consists of two 6-inch 55 Watt lights which are mounted on the front bumper inboard of the headlamp assemblies. The Auxiliary Light Kit can be illuminated when the driver activates the vehicle's high beam lights. The illumination of the Auxiliary Light Kit with the vehicle's high beams causes the vehicle to exceed one of the allowable lighting thresholds specified in FMVSS 108. Light intensities above the maximum allowable limit could cause increased glare for oncoming traffic and increase the risk of a crash.

Q1a: What is the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit?

A1a: The Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit is an optional Toyota accessory which consists of two bumper or brush guard mounted 6-inch round lights and two FJ branded covers to protect the lights when not in use. Please refer to the following images for reference.



<u>Q2: How many Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits are covered by this Safety (Non-Compliance)</u> <u>Recall?</u>

A2: There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter for 2007 to 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser Vehicles.

Q2a: Are there any other Toyota or Lexus vehicles covered?

A2a: No. The Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit was designed only for use on 2007 to 2013 FJ Cruiser models.

Q2b: Which and how many vehicles are covered by this Safety Recall?

A2b: There are approximately 11,500 vehicles that could have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory installed. To ensure that dealer installations and over-the-counter accessory sales customers are notified, approximately 209,000 letters will be mailed to all 2007 through certain 2013 Model Year FJ Cruiser owners.

Q3: What is Toyota going to do?

A3: If the vehicle is equipped with a Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, any authorized Toyota dealer will replace the Auxiliary Light Brackets and Bulbs at **NO CHARGE** to the vehicle owner. Only vehicles equipped with a Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit will require repair.

Q3a: How and when will Toyota notify owner of vehicles covered by this Safety (Non-Compliance) Recall?

A3a: The owner notification is anticipated to start in late May, 2013.

There are approximately 11,500 Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kits which were installed at vehicle processing centers, by dealers, or sold over the counter. In order to identify all the vehicles which may have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit installed Toyota will be mailing owner notices to all owners of 2007 to 2013 model year FJ Cruiser vehicles; this mailing will include approximately 209,000 letters.

If the vehicle does **NOT** have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, it is **NOT** involved in this Safety Recall.

Q3b: How does Toyota obtain my mailing information?


A3b: Toyota uses an industry provider who works with each state Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to receive registration or title information. Please make sure your registration or title information is correct.

Q3c: Do I need my owner letter to have the remedy performed?

A3c: You do not need an owner letter to have this recall completed; however, to assist the dealer in confirming vehicle eligibility, we request that you present the owner notification at the time of your service appointment.

Q4: Can I inspect my vehicle to determine if it has the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit?

A4: Yes, you can reference the images shown below to determine if your vehicle is equipped with the optional Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory.



If so equipped, please contact your local authorized Toyota dealer as soon as possible to schedule an appointment to have the remedy performed.

If the vehicle does **NOT** have the Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit, it is **NOT** involved in this Safety Recall and no additional action is necessary.

Q4a: What if I am not comfortable performing the inspection?

A4a: Any authorized Toyota dealer will be more than happy to perform an inspection at **no charge** to you to determine if your vehicle is covered by this safety recall.

Q5: How long will the repair take?

A5: If your vehicle is equipped with a Genuine Toyota Auxiliary Light Kit accessory, the repair will take approximately 2 hours. However, depending upon the dealer's work schedule, it may be necessary to make the vehicle available for a longer period of time.

Q6: What if I previously paid for repairs to my vehicle for this condition?

A6: Please refer to the remedy owner letter for instructions to request reimbursement for previous repair costs. Please note that the dealer must complete the Safety Recall remedy before reimbursement consideration requests can be processed.
