Information: This is to inform you of a Recall Campaign on the above-mentioned vehicles. **There is a possibility that**

passenger seats with connectors for the seat occupancy detection control unit that do not meet the required specifications may have been installed in the affected vehicles.

This can activate the airbag warning light in the instrument cluster. If this happens, the airbags on the

passenger's side will not work.

Action Required:

Replace passenger seat.

Affected Vehicles:

The VIN(s) can be checked by using PIWIS Vehicle Information link to verify if the campaign affects the vehicle. This campaign is scope specific to the VIN! Failure to verify in PIWIS may result in an improper

repair. This campaign affects 98 vehicles in North America.

Parts Info: **NOTE: DO NOT ORDER PARTS.**

1. FOR CUSTOMER-OWNED VEHICLES, PCNA WILL CONTACT THE CUSTOMER AND ASK THEM WHICH DEALER THEY WOULD LIKE TO INSTALL THE REPLACEMENT SEAT. PCNA WILL THEN CREATE A PDX

ORDER TO SHIP THE SEAT(S) DIRECTLY TO THE DEALER OF THE CUSTOMER'S CHOICE.

2. FOR IN-STOCK VEHICLES WITH AN OPEN AD04 RECALL, PLEASE SEND IN A PTEC/PAV WITH THE VEHICLE VIN AND PCNA WILL PLACE A PDX ORDER FOR YOU. THE VEHICLE MUST BE ON YOUR LOT AND BE THERE WHEN THE SEAT(S) ARRIVES AT YOUR DEALERSHIP. DO NOT SEND IN A PTEC/PAV IF YOU DO

NOT HAVE THE VEHICLE IN YOUR POSSESSION.

3. BOLTS (4 PER SEAT) WILL BE SHIPPED TO DEALERSHIPS SEPARATELY FROM THE SEATS.

Attachment "A": Work Procedure

- 1 Replace passenger seat as described under ⇒ Workshop Manual '720119 Removing and installing front seat'.
- Reset occupant detection learning values on passenger seat > Workshop Manual '696855 Replacing occupant detection control unit' section on replacing occupant detection control unit.



Information

The **replaced seats** will be assigned a barcode to facilitate the entire passenger seat's return to your regional PDC.

- 3 Check that electric seat adjustment and seat heating/ventilation (if these options are available) are working.
- 4 Once a barcode is provided, return the entire passenger seat to your regional PDC.
- 5 Enter the recall campaign and replacement of the side airbag unit on the passenger's side in the Warranty and Maintenance booklet.

Attachment "B": Claim Submission - Recall Campaign AD04

Warranty claims should be submitted via WWS/PQIS.

Open campaigns may be checked by using either the PIWIS Vehicle Information system or through PQIS Job Creation.

Labor, parts, and sublet will be automatically inserted when Technician is selected in WWS/PQIS. If necessary, the required part numbers will need to be manually entered into warranty system by the dealer administrator.
