

IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

This notice applies to your vehicle, VIN:_	
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Dear General Motors Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in your 2013 model year Cadillac SRX vehicle equipped with the 18 inch wheel. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in safety recall 13116.
- Schedule an appointment with your Cadillac dealer.
- This service will be performed for you at **no charge**.

General Motors recently discovered a data system issue which may have caused some current owners of vehicles -- that were originally purchased by fleet buyers in the U.S. and Canada -- to not receive certain recall communications from GM. This issue may have prevented prior letters concerning this recall from reaching you, which is why you are receiving this letter. We have corrected our data system and apologize for any delay in providing this letter to you.

In cooperation with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) we recommend that you check your vehicle identification number periodically at the GM recall website (https://recalls.gm.com) or at NHTSA's website (https://vinrcl.safercar.gov/vin/), where you can find the most up-to-date recall information for your vehicle.

Why is your vehicle being recalled

Your vehicle may experience loosening of the wheel nuts. If this occurs, a creaking, rattling or grinding noise may originate from the wheel area. A steering vibration may also be present. If unnoticed or ignored, one or more of the wheel lug nuts could detach, or fatigue. The wheel attachment studs may fracture. If this happens while the vehicle is moving, a crash could result without prior warning.

What will we do?

Your Cadillac dealer will remove and reinstall the wheel nuts by performing a tire rotation. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual time of approximately 20 minutes to perform this service.

If your vehicle is within the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, your dealer may provide you with shuttle service or some other form of courtesy transportation while your vehicle is at the dealership for this repair. Please refer to your Owner Manual and your dealer for details on courtesy transportation.

What should you do?

You should contact your Cadillac dealer to arrange a service appointment as soon as possible.
