Dear Peterbilt Customer,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Peterbilt has decided that certain model 567 and 579 with Allison transmissions built between January 29, 2013 and October 9, 2013 do not have power supplied to the gear shifter display for backlighting. Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain a defect.

Backlighting is used to aid the driver in selecting a gear in low light situations. The lack of backlighting may create a situation where it is difficult to know what gear is selected which may lead to an injury accident or property damage.


