If you own a 2004 through 2013 GSX-R600 or GSX-R750, or a 2005 through 2013 GSX-R1000, it may be affected by one or more Safety Recall Campaigns.


You may not be the original purchaser, or we may have been unable to contact you. But if you have a GSX-R affected by a Safety Recall, you want to make sure it's inspected and repaired. Your safety is our highest priority!

**#1 CHECK TO SEE IF YOUR GSX-R IS INCLUDED IN A SAFETY RECALL CAMPAIGN.**

Go to <http://www.suzukicycles.com/Recalls> and enter your Vehicle Identification Number (VIN).


The VIN on your GSX-R is stamped on the steering head of the frame. It is also listed on your motorcycle registration card. You may also find it on the side of the motorcycle's frame.

You can also scan this QR code for additional information, which will help you identify if your motorcycle is in need of this important Safety Recall.
