**Problem Description:**

Tishomingo Acquisition, LLC (Tishomingo) is recalling certain model year 2012-2015 Ox Trailers Quarter Frame dump trailers manufactured August 27, 2012, to December 1, 2014. The draft arm of the affected trailers may crack or break.

**Consequence:**

If the draft arm breaks, a loss of vehicle control may result, increasing the risk of a crash.

**Remedy:**

Tishomingo has notified owners, and will replace the draft arm, free of charge. The recall began on December 19, 2014. Owners may contact Tishomingo customer service at 1-800-255-4345.

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on, or before, 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
