This letter updates in part General Motors' letter of March 31, 2014, and is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6 as it applies to a determination by General Motors of a noncompliance recall involving 2009-2014 model year Chevrolet Express and GMC Savana vehicles.

Specifically, the information submitted pursuant to 49 CFR 573.6(c)(8) below supersedes information included in General Motors' letter of March 31, 2014. The dealer repair procedure for the 2012-2014 model year Chevrolet Express and GMC Savana 1500 series vehicles, has an additional repair of replacing the front passenger seat belt retractor. With the addition of the trim piece on the passenger side instrument panel, the retractor load limit will be changed from 2.0 kN to 2.5 kN for the 2012 thru 2014 MY

<u>573.6(c)(8)</u>: Dealers are to install a trim piece on the passenger side instrument panel on all vehicles, and on 2012-2014 model year vehicles, dealers are to also replace the front passenger seat belt retractor.

GM sent recall dealer bulletin 14105 on April 24, 2014, and anticipates mailing the owner letters mid May 2014.

Pursuant to 577.11(e), GM does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because this remedy was not previously known to or available from dealers or other service providers.
