Dear Ms. Lewis:

On March 20, 2014, CrossRoads submitted notification in accordance with 49CFR Part 573 to make NHTSA aware of safety defect with certain trailers manufactured by CrossRoads. Additionally, CrossRoads submitted an update to its original 573 letter on April 28, 2014 increasing the population of affected units in the original population. NHTSA has issued recall number 14V-134 to this issue. CrossRoads is filing this update to increase the number of units in the population, add an additional model affected by this safety defect, and expand the time range in which the trailers were built. The new population and date range of manufacture are as follows:

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The trailers built with the safety defect are as follows:

These trailers were built between March 8, 2013 and February 27, 2014. The total number of trailers subject to this recall campaign is 298.
