Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Jayco, Inc. (“Jayco” or the “Company”) is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a recall campaign, which is being voluntarily initiated. Specific information is as follows:

573.6(c)(2)

Affected vehicles are certain model year:

2013 Seneca Class C Motor Homes , Pinnacle and Eagle Premier Fifth Wheels

2014 Seneca Class C Motor Homes, Precept Class A Motor Homes , Pinnacle and Eagle Premier Fifth Wheels

The affected vehicles were manufactured January 14, 2013 through February 6, 2014.

The recall population was determined from the manufacturing records for the Company’s manufacturing plant in Middlebury , Indiana, which produced the affected recreational vehicles.

A total of 393 vehicles are subject to this recall.

Jayco is recalling 100 percent of the affected vehicles identified in the scope.

573.6(c)(5)

Certain Frigidaire KG Series Model CFMV152CLB and CFMV154CLS Convection Microwaves manufactured January 2013 through June 2, 2013 with the serial numbers beginning with KG301 through KG322 that were installed in the vehicles listed, may activate and begin heating on its own. If nothing is in the cavity of the oven, there is no risk of smoke or fire due to this defect. If items are being stored in the cavity and the microwave activates it could result in excessive heat, smoke or possible fire inside the microwave.

573.6(c)(6)

After receiving reports in March 2014 that Frigidaire Convection Microwaves were activating on their own, Jayco contacted Mid West Sales and Service (Jayco's supplier for the Frigidaire Convection Microwave). April 2014, Jayco was informed by Mid West Sales and Service that an investigation conducted by the manufacture of the Frigidaire Convection Microwave, Electrolux Home Products, determined a quality defect with the touch membrane/keypad could cause one of the three Easy Set Keys to activate the microwave unattended. As an act of Exceptional Customer Care, Jayco has decided to conduct a recall.

573.6(c)(8)

The remedy for the effected vehicles is to replace the membrane/ keypad. In the interim, Consumers should unplug their Convection Microwave until repaired.

Jayco will be conducting this recall and is currently working with Electrolux to finalize the details of the administration of the recall repair. Jayco will submit our notification letter for your approval once all the details are finalized.

We anticipate the letters will be mailed within 10 working days upon approval and Recall Number assigned by NHTSA.
