Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Jayco, Inc. (“Jayco Inc.” or the “Company”) is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a recall campaign, which is being voluntarily initiated. Specific information is as follows:

573.6(c)(2)

Affected vehicles are certain model year:

2013 Seneca Class C Motor Homes , Pinnacle and Eagle Premier Fifth Wheels

2014 Seneca Class C Motor Homes, Precept Class A Motor Homes , Pinnacle and Eagle Premier Fifth Wheels

The affected vehicles were manufactured **January 14, 2013 through August 26, 2013.**

The recall population was determined from the manufacturing records for the Company’s manufacturing plant in Middlebury , Indiana, which produced the affected recreational vehicles.

A total of **192** vehicles are subject to this recall.

Jayco is recalling 100 percent of the affected vehicles identified in the scope.

573.6(c)(5)

Certain Frigidaire KG Series Model CFMV152CLB and CFMV154CLS Convection Microwaves manufactured between **January 27, 2013 through April 10, 2013 in the serial number range KG30607951 through KG31600670** were installed in the vehicles listed, and may activate and begin heating while unattended. If nothing is in the cavity of the oven, there is no risk of smoke or fire due to this defect. If items are being stored in the cavity and the microwave activates, it could result in excessive heat, smoke or possible fire inside the microwave.

After receiving reports in March 2014 that Frigidaire Convection Microwaves were activating on their own, Jayco contacted Mid West Sales and Service ( Jayco's supplier for the Frigidaire Convection Microwave). April 2014, Jayco was informed by Mid West Sales and Service that an investigation conducted by the Manufacturer of the Frigidaire Convection Microwave, Electrolux Home Products, determined a possible quality defect with the touch membrane/keypad could cause one of the three Easy Set Keys to activate the microwave when unattended. As an act of Exceptional Customer Care, Jayco in conjunction with Electrolux decided to conduct a recall.

The remedy for the affected vehicles is for an authorized Electrolux service technician to replace the membrane/ keypad at no charge to the customer. In the interim, Consumers should unplug their Convection Microwave until repaired.

Jayco, Inc. is submitting the Owner notification for your approval in addition to the Revised 573. We are prepared to release the recall in May 2014 pending NHTSA approval and assignment of a Recall Number.
