2. **Vehicles Affected:** **Make/Model:** MY 2013 Go-4 with 20V Caliper  
**Engine Displacement:** 996cc  
**Production Period:** June 2013 – December 2013
3. **Approximately 80 vehicles are affected. The campaign relates to the front brake rotor on vehicles with 20V front calipers.**

4. The percentage of vehicles estimated to contain the defect is 100%.
5. This recall involves front brake rotor originally installed on the subject vehicles. Over time, worn front pad(s) may be ejected from the caliper due to a large gap between the caliper and the non-vented brake rotor. This increases vehicle stopping distance due to compromised front braking performance.
6. Westward Industries was notified by a dealer of a potential issue with ejection of worn front brake pads. After a quality control review it was determined that front brake pad ejection may occur on those vehicles equipped with 20V calipers.
7. Not applicable.
8. The thin, non-vented front brake rotor will be replaced with a thicker, vented rotor reducing the gap between the caliper and rotor thus preventing worn brake pad ejection.

We expect to begin dealer notification within 10 business days following NHTSA's approval of our owner and dealer notification letters.
