The following information is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6 as it applies to a determination by General Motors to conduct a safety related recall involving some 2014 model year Buick Enclave, Chevrolet Traverse and GMC Acadia vehicles.

573.6(c)(1): Buick, Chevrolet and GMC Brands of General Motors Company.

573.6(c)(2)(3)(4): This information is shown on the attached sheet.

573.6(c)(5): General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some 2014 model year Buick Enclave, Chevrolet Traverse and GMC Acadia vehicles. A calibration in the engine control module (ECM) may result in inaccurate fuel gauge readings at both the high and low end of the fuel range by as much as one quarter of a tank. If the fuel gauge wrongly indicates more fuel than is actually present, the customer can run out of fuel. If a customer runs out of fuel while driving, the vehicle will stall, increasing the risk of a crash.

573.6(c)(6): The issue was presented to the Field Performance Evaluation Review Committee on April 14, 2014, and on April 22, 2014, the Executive Field Action Decision Committee decided to conduct a safety recall. General Motors will be submitting a supplemental chronology within two weeks.

573.6(c)(8): Dealers are to reprogram the ECM with a new software calibration.

General Motors will provide the dealer bulletin and owner letter mail dates when available.

Pursuant to 577.11, General Motors does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.

573.6(c)(10): General Motors will provide the dealer bulletin and owner letter under separate cover.



573.6(c)(11): General Motors' assigned recall number is 14007.
