Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Starcraft RV (“Starcraft” or the “Company”) is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a recall campaign, which is being voluntarily initiated. Specific information is as follows:

573.6(c)(2)

Affected vehicles are 2015 Starcraft 18QB AR-ONE travel trailers.

The affected vehicles were manufactured between June 18, 2014 and June 23, 2014.

The recall population was determined from the manufacturing records for the Company’s manufacturing plants in Topeka, Indiana, which produced the affected recreational vehicles.

573.6(c)(3)

A total of 42 vehicles are subject to this recall.

Specific Vehicle Identification Numbers (VINs) are as follows:

1SABS0AJ4F28P5051 through 1SABA0AJ7F28P5092

573.6(c)(4)

Starcraft is recalling 100 percent of the affected vehicles identified in the scope.

573.6(c)(5)

Starcraft has decided that certain vehicles fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110, "Tire selection and rims and motor home/recreation vehicle trailer load carrying capacity information for motor vehicles with a GVWR of 4,536 kilograms (10,000 pounds) or less. Starcraft has decided that due to an error when weighing the affected vehicles, an incorrect cargo carrying capacity is printed on the Cargo Carrying Capacity label (CCC) and the Tire label. This error may allow overloading of the trailer, exceeding the Gross

Vehicle Weight Rating. Overloading of tires may lead to tire failure, increasing the risk of a crash.

573.6(c)(6)

During a routine internal inspection, it was discovered that an error occurred when the affected units were weighed, resulting in incorrect cargo carrying capacity being printed on the CCC and Tire Labels.

573.6(c)(8)

The remedy for the affected vehicles is for Starcraft to reprint all the Cargo Carrying Capacity Labels and Tire Labels noting the correct weight and Dealers to remove the incorrect labels and replace with the new labels showing the correct information.

All effected units are currently in Dealers inventory; subsequently a retail notification is not applicable. Starcraft is releasing corrected labels to the Dealers prior to receiving a Recall number from NHTSA. This is to expedite the recall repair prior to the units being retail sold. Upon receipt of the recall number, Starcraft will provide all required documents under that assigned number. Starcraft is prepared to send the corrected labels to all Dealers that have these units in their inventory by July 11, 2014.
