Description of the Defect : The cylinder's pressure relief valve may not withstand engine compartment temperatures, which can result in loss of the extinguishing agent (i.e. nitrogen).

Description of the Safety Risk : If a fire occurs, the system would not be available to assist with extinguishing the fire, which may increase the risk of personal injury.

There have been no reports of injuries associated with this defect; therefore, Prevost considers this as a proactive measure to protect the public and Prevost's customers from risk of personal injury.
