## Introduction

Peterbilt has been notified by Sure Power Inc. that certain Model 210 and 220 vehicles built between July 29, 2011 and January 3, 2014 were manufactured with a 12 – 24 volt DC converter that could fail. Solder joints in the converter may fracture due to thermal stresses. When fractured, these joints may lead to a fire which may cause an accident involving personal injury and/or property damage.

## Resolution

Replace defective 12-24 volt converters.

---

**It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to sell or lease new vehicles covered by this recall until the defect or noncompliance has been corrected.**

---
