SUBJECT: FL654/FL661 – Revised Bulletin

This letter is to inform you that a second revised bulletin for Recall FL654 that also covers FL661, both titled *IMMI Seat Belt Buckles*, has been posted on AccessFreightliner.com. FL661 has been added to comply with government requirements. Please print and use the FL654/FL661 bulletin for all work under FL654 and FL661 from this point forward.

REVISIONS: The U.S. vehicles previously added to the Recall have been moved under a separate recall number, FL661 and NHTSA #14V-150, to comply with a directive from NHTSA. The repair procedure is the same and all vehicles in both FL654 and FL661 will use the kits with "FL654" in the kit number (for example, FL654C and FL661C are the same except for the recall number and will both use 25-FL654-006).
