RE: Stop Sale/Safety Recall: 2014-15 RLX LED Headlight Reflector Film Delaminates

On December 11, 2014 Acura notified NHTSA of a **Stop Sale** order and **Safety Recall** for 9,468 model year 2014-15 RLX and 283 RLX Sport Hybrid vehicles. Any new or used vehicles in dealer stock must be repaired per S/B 14-051, *Safety Recall: LED Headlight Reflector Film Delaminates* prior to sale. **Refer to the eResponsibility report or VIN Inquiry status to determine which vehicles in your inventory are affected.**

Problem

The reflective film backing material inside the headlights may delaminate, which may result in the vehicle no longer conforming to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108.

Repair

Affected vehicles require replacement of both the right and left headlight assemblies with countermeasured parts.

Parts

Parts are currently available in limited supply. Initial parts will be allocated to dealers; once sufficient stock has been received, Acura will notify dealers of the increased availability.

Warranty

Warranty information is detailed in S/B 14-051, *Safety Recall: LED Headlight Reflector Film Delaminates*. Note that Acura is waving the standard 30-day parts retention period requirement due to the size of the replaced headlight assemblies.

Service Bulletin

In support of this recall, S/B 14-051 has been posted on SIS as of December 12, 2014. It includes repair, parts, and warranty information related to this campaign.

Customer Notification

Acura expects to complete initial customer notification by early February 2015.

As always, make sure to check the iN VIN status inquiry to determine if a vehicle is eligible for this (or any) open recall.
