AFFECTED VEHICLES: Certain 2006 Raider Trucks built July 1, 2005 to July 31, 2006

PURPOSE

On December 16, 2014, Fiat Chrysler Automobiles (FCA) announced to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) a safety recall involving the clutch interlock switch installed on 2006 Raider trucks built July 1, 2005 to July 31, 2006 and equipped with a manual transmission. The clutch interlock switch on affected trucks may contain a return spring that fatigues. A fatigued clutch interlock switch return spring could allow the driver to engage the engine starter motor without the clutch pedal being depressed, which could result in unintended vehicle movement when starting the vehicle.

To comply with federal regulations, an interim notification will be mailed to owners of affected vehicles on February 9, 2015, informing them the part required to remedy their vehicle is currently unavailable. **A follow-up notification will be mailed when parts become available**, instructing them to contact their local Authorized Mitsubishi Motors dealership to schedule an appointment and have this recall performed.

MMNA expects to provide the Recall Campaign Bulletin outlining the repair procedure on MEDIC and MDL in late February / early March. An ATIN will be distributed once this recall campaign (SR-15-001) is officially launched. IMPORTANT

Affected new or used inventory vehicles must be repaired before the vehicle is delivered. Dealers must check their inventory vehicles' VINs on the Warranty Super Screen to verify whether the vehicle is involved in this recall campaign. It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle or any new or used item of motor vehicle equipment (including a tire) covered by the notification under a sale or lease until the defect or noncompliance is remedied.
